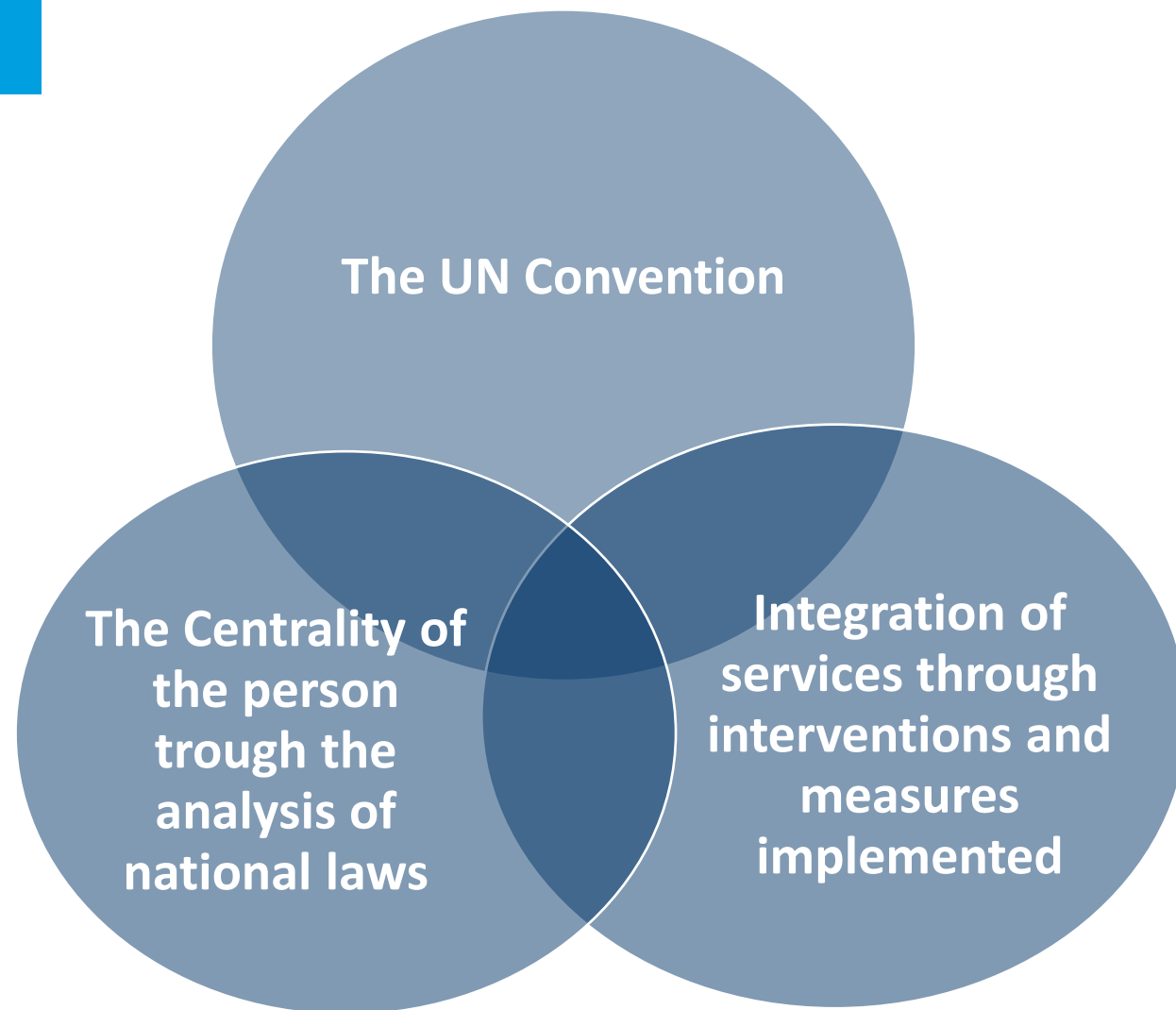

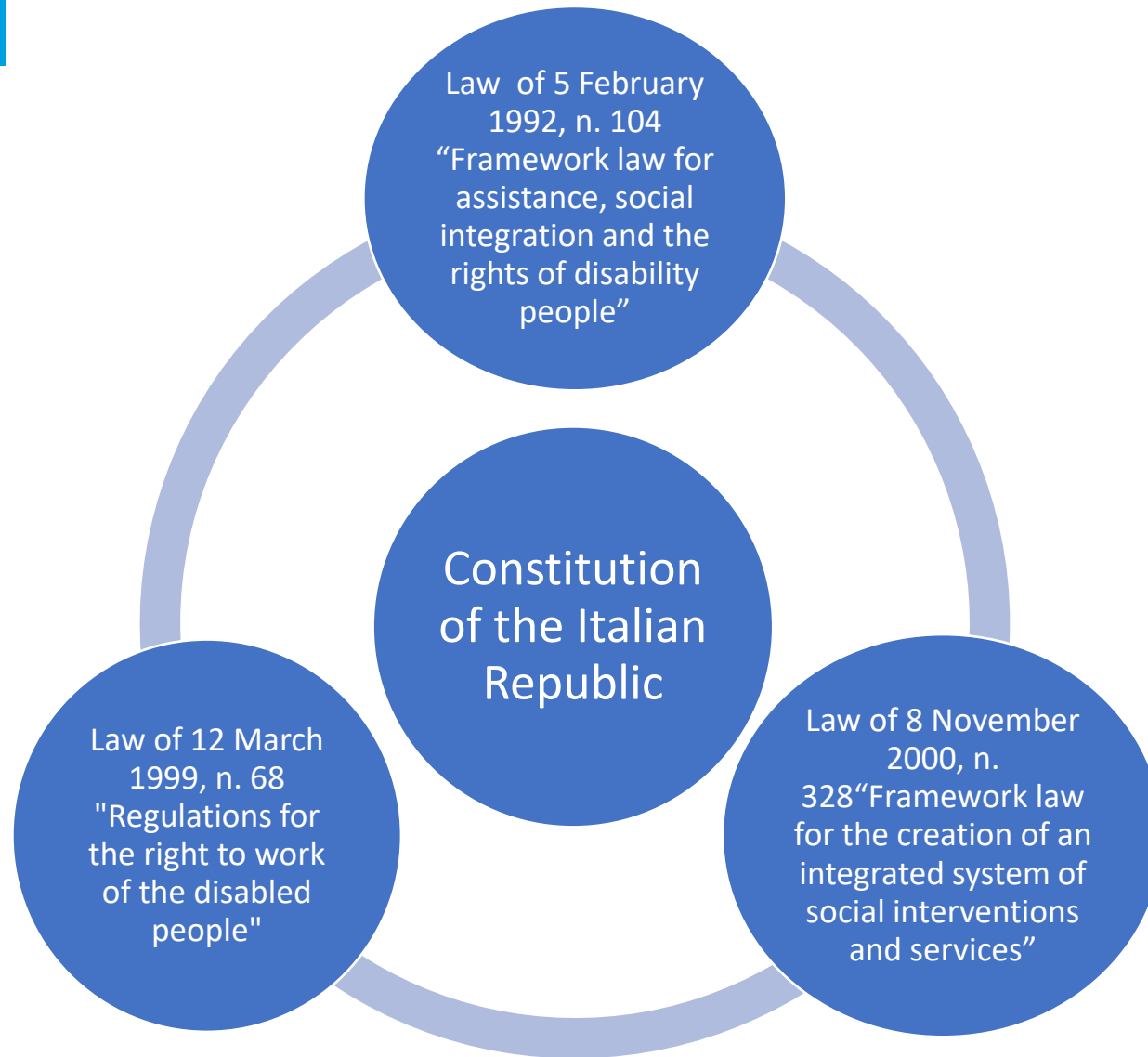

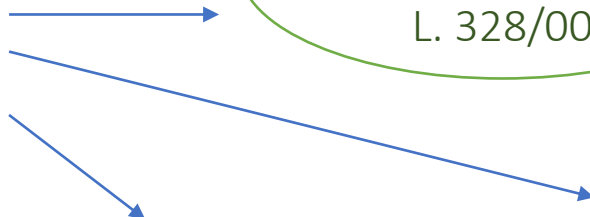

Almost 1 person with disabilities out of 3 (32.1%) is at risk of poverty

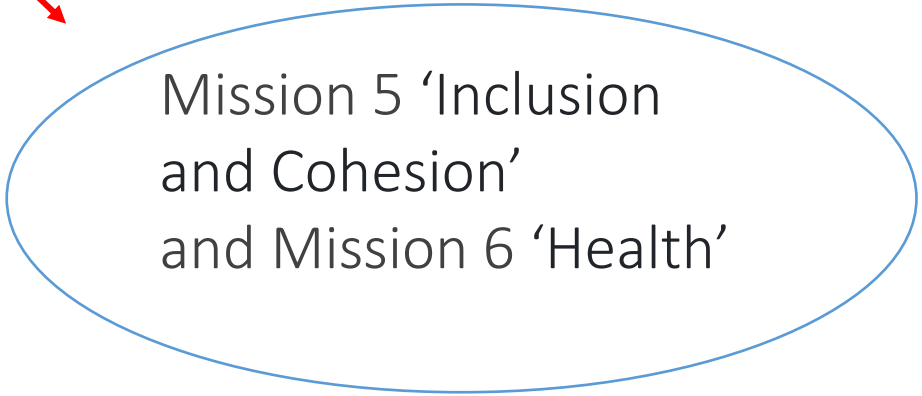
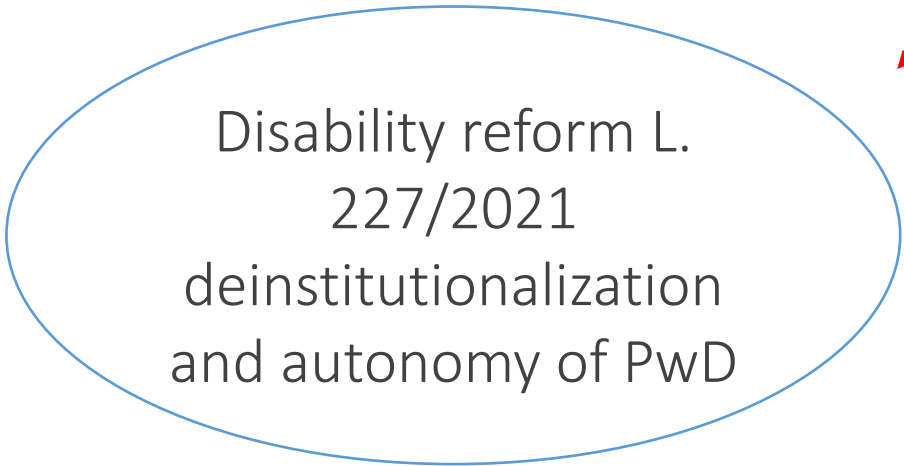
