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The Italian Educational and Vocational Training System

Following the reform of Title V of the Constitution (2001) vocational training comes under the jurisdiction of the 21 Regions and Autonomous Provinces, whereas education comes under the shared jurisdiction of State and Regions

The Italian Educational and Vocational Training System: Key Words

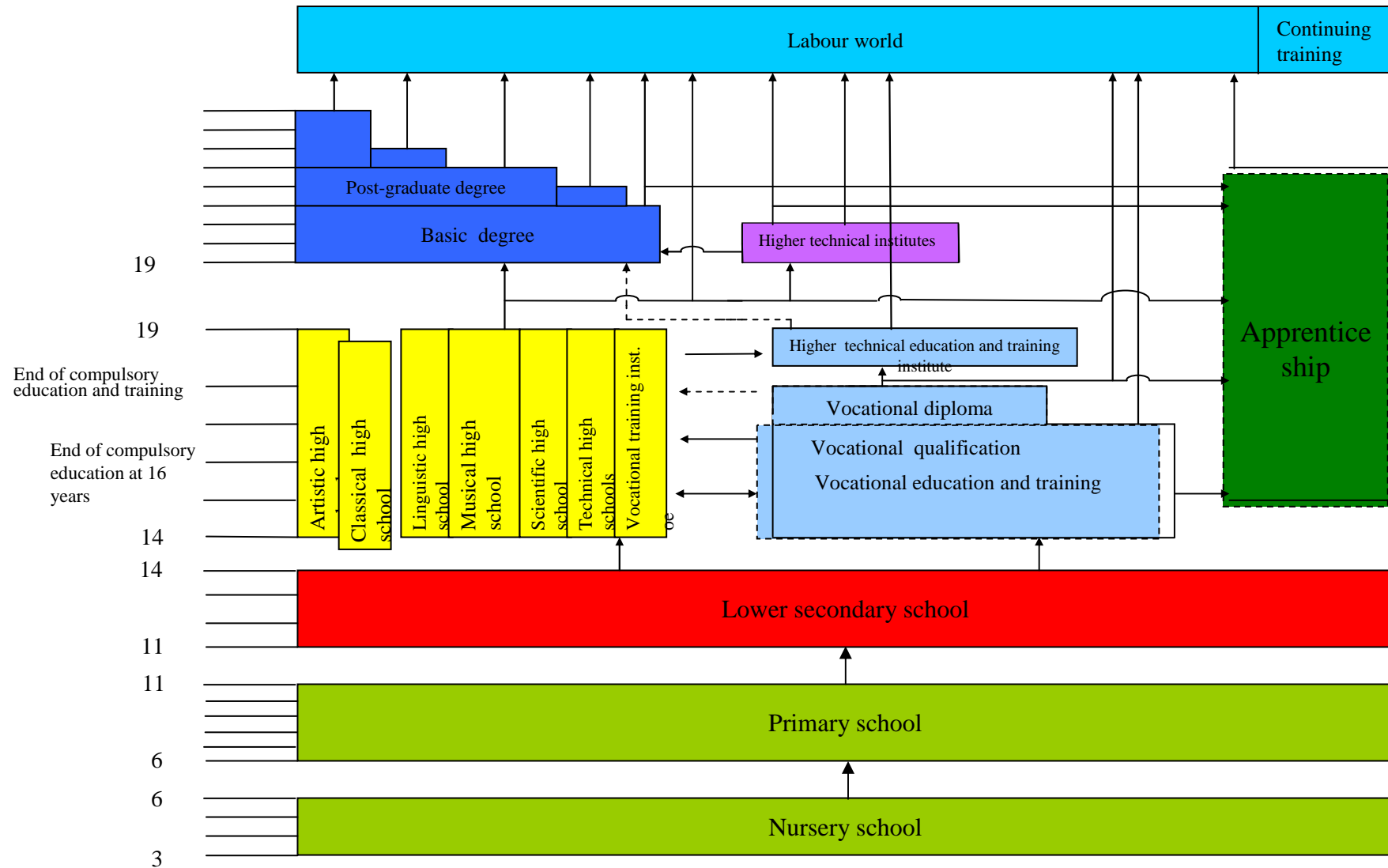
Compulsory education up to 16 years of age

Education is compulsory for at least 10 years and is aimed at the acquisition of an upper-secondary school certificate or at least a three-year vocational qualification by 18 years. The working age has been raised from 15 to 16 years.

Right-Duty up to 18 years of age

Education and vocational training for at least 12 years or anyway until the acquisition of an upper-secondary school certificate by 18 years is a legally enforceable civil right and duty.

The system has recently undergone an important reform and standardization also within the EQF framework

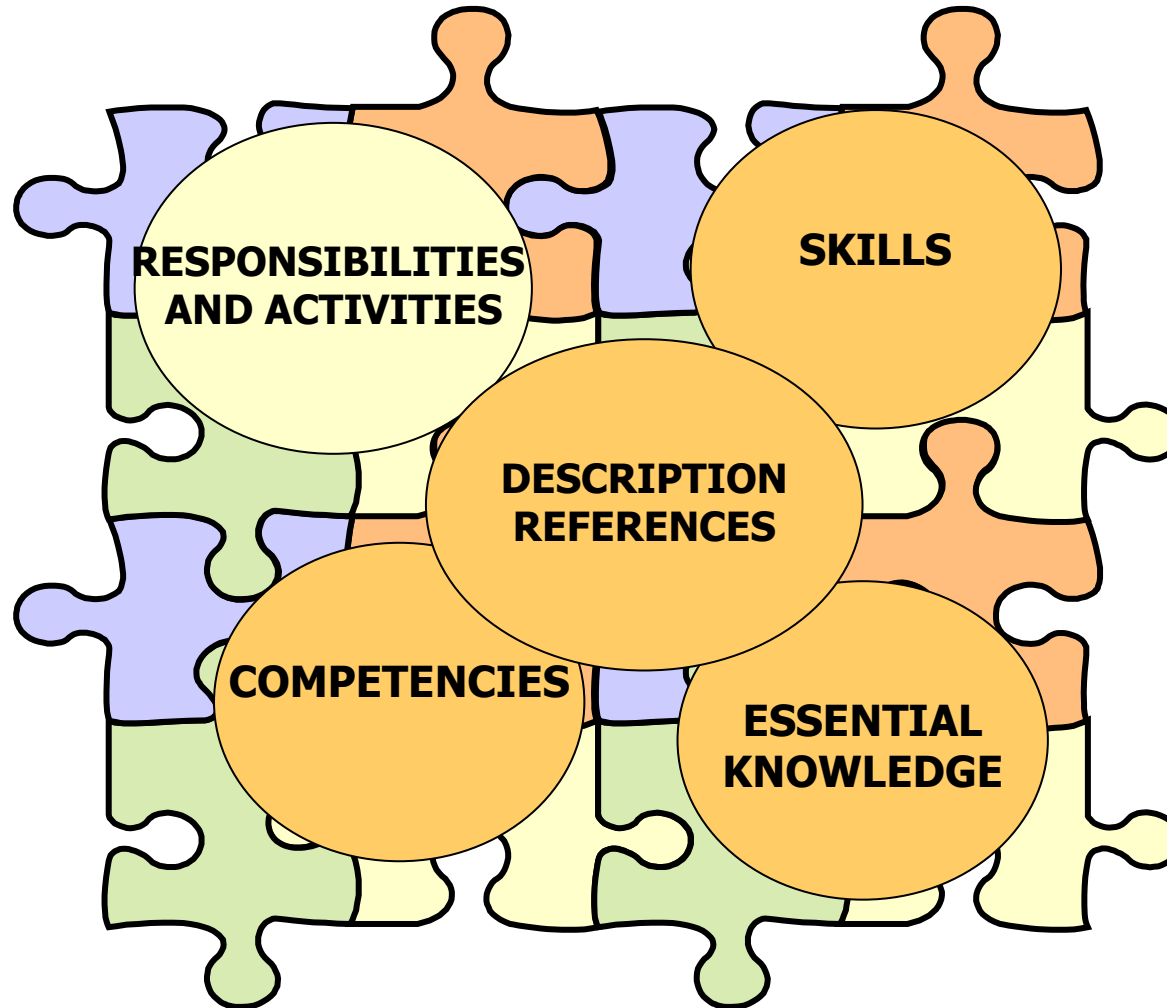
