Social and spatial inequalities

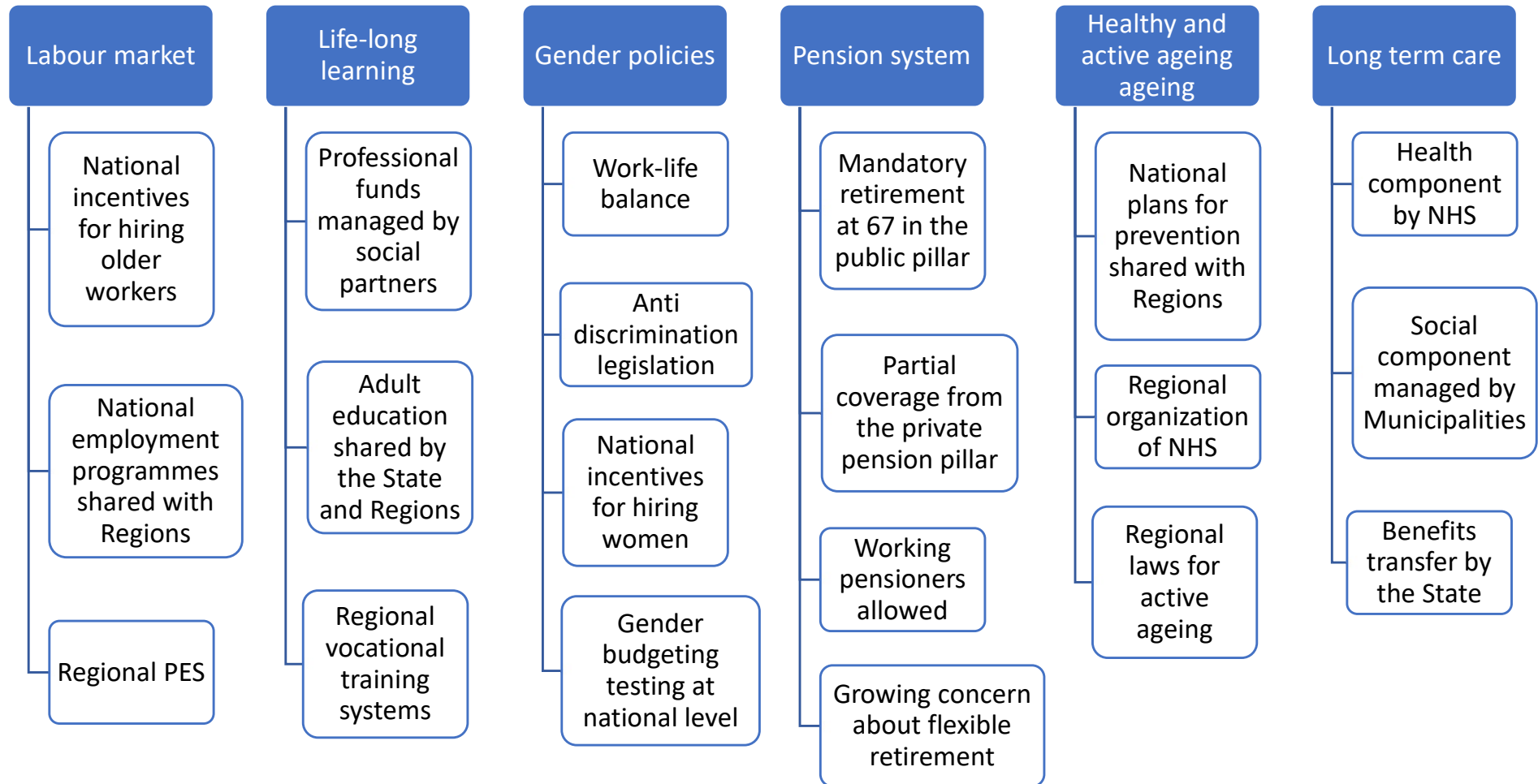
Health inequalities, also connected to health determinants

Social perception of population ageing and older persons

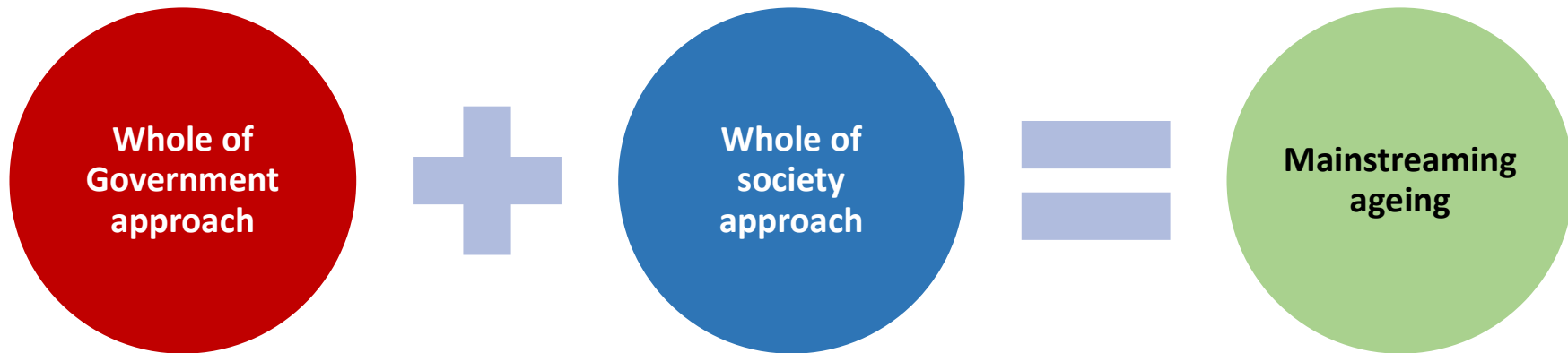


PUBLIC SECTOR, WELFARE AND POLICIES

The structure of the Italian public sector in general, and the welfare system in particular, still cause a certain fragmentation of policies, also in relation to the different social groups addressed

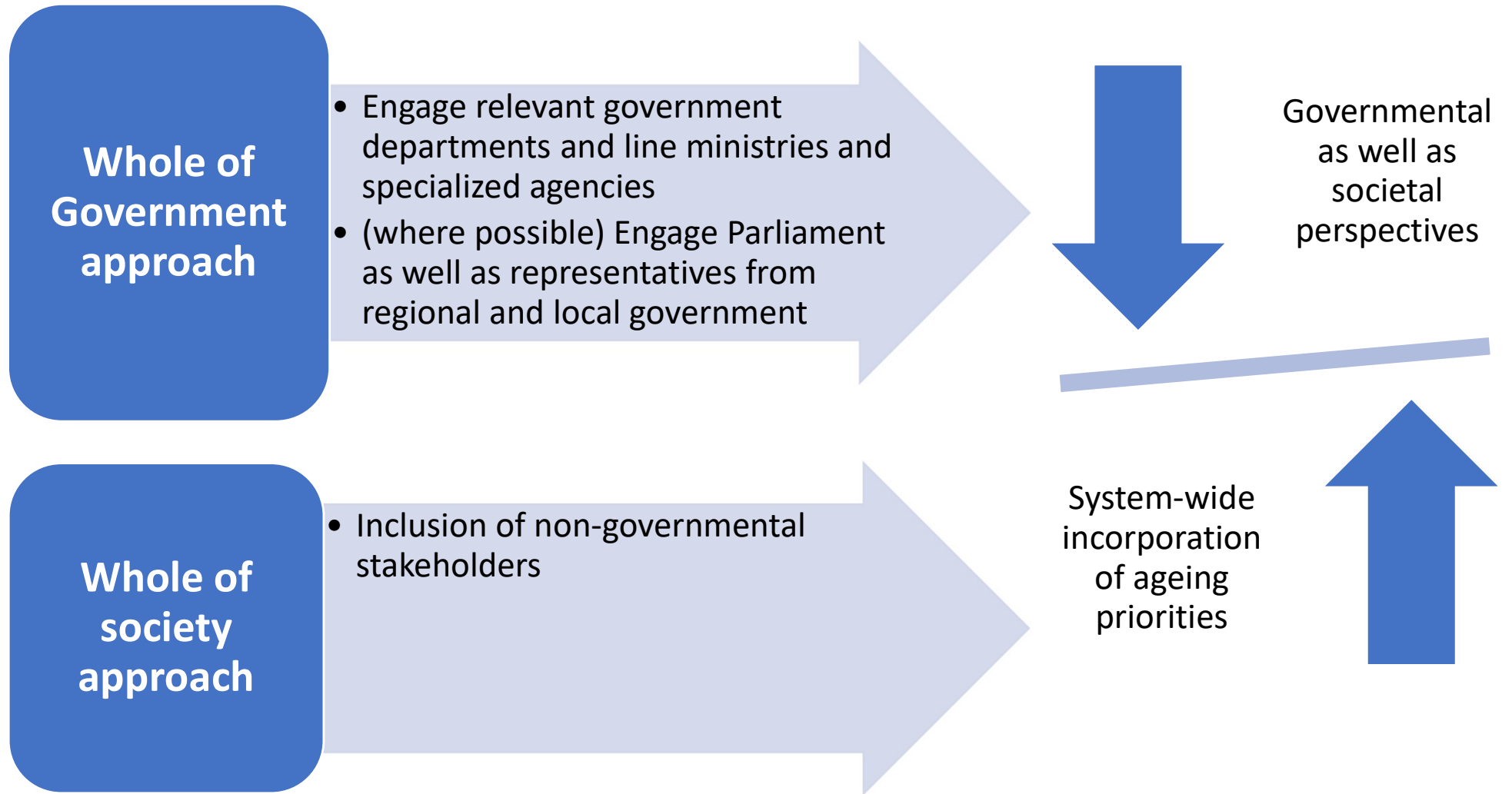


NEW APPROACHES



- ✓ Adopting a whole of Government approach and a whole of society approach at the same time seems the most effective way to overcome existing policy fragmentation and bottlenecks
- ✓ Overarching goal  Mainstreaming ageing in all policies

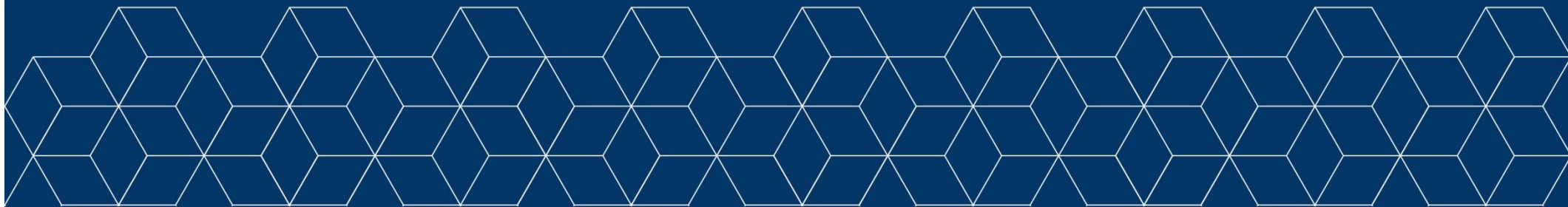
